As part of his Fiscal Year 2009 budget submission, President Bush proposed eliminating ATUS as an offset to help cover the rising costs of the Current Population Survey. The Population Association of America and Association of Population Centers will be working with other social and behavioral research organizations to urge Congress to provide the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) with an overall increase in its budget. If the agency receives an increase, we would hope neither survey would be curtailed or eliminated.
